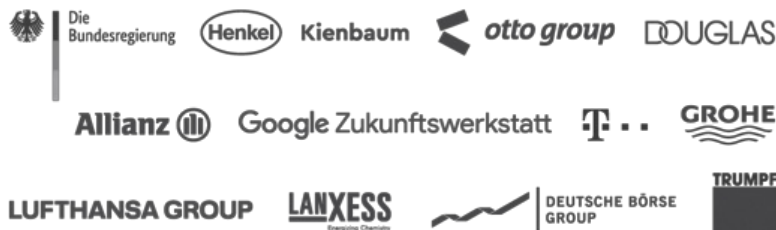
Earning Criteria:
